**RULES GOVERNING THE MISSOURI SMALLFLOWS ORGANIZATION, INC,
SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE & THE DARYEL BROCK MEMORIAL
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM – College Recipient**

The following is a set of rules that have been agreed to by the Missouri Smallflows Organization, Board of Directors to ensure there are adequate checks and balances within the Daryel Brock Memorial Scholarship Program. All individuals who actively participate in the Scholarship Committee and Daryel Brock Memorial Scholarship Program will be subject to them.

**\$500.00 Daryel Brock Memorial Scholarship
Non-Renewable**

1. Eligible applicants for the Daryel Brock Memorial Scholarship are those attending college and majoring/minoring in a science related field to the environment.
2. Applicants must have an average 3.2 GPA.
3. Selection is competitive and is based on:
 - (a) Academic standing of the student during all years of college
 - (b) Extracurricular activities and leadership
 - (c) Character reference and other pertinent factors
4. The awardee may attend any accredited college, university or technical school of their choice in the United States, but must be enrolled as a full-time student at the college, university or technical school and maintain a minimum of a 12 credit hour schedule.
5. The scholarship will be awarded for one year only; non-renewable scholarship.
6. The award will be made payable to the selected applicant and the scholarship will be sent to the home of the applicant to remit to the college, university or technical school of his or her choice, *only* after the applicant has submitted documentation to the scholarship committee that they have been enrolled in their college, university or technical school. An example of that documentation is a copy of semesters schedule stating the individual is enrolled for the school year the scholarship has been awarded.
7. Applications are to be submitted on forms provided by the Missouri Smallflows Organization, Inc. These forms will be sent to the student upon written request, stating their interest in applying for the scholarship.

8. Applicants shall submit a complete application within the specified deadlines to receive consideration for the scholarship and must include a transcript of college grades covering all full semesters. *Applications will only be sent out after written request from the student.*
9. Applicants shall submit a Letter of Recommendation from a school official with their application.
10. Applicants shall submit a one-page essay covering his or her collegiate/scholastic/professional goals and objectives with the student's application form.
11. Scoring will be based on a scale of 1 – 25, with one representing the lowest score and twenty five representing the highest score. The four categories will include; Academic Standing/Grades, Extra Curricular Activities/Leadership, Letter of Recommendation and Essay. The highest total score wins the scholarship. None of the information related to the scoring process will be released to the applicant or any other individual. There are no exceptions to this rule.
12. In judging scholarship applications, the Scholarship Committee shall select alternates. Such alternates shall only be eligible in the event that one or more of the applicants initially selected should for any reason be unable to accept the award.
13. After the scholarships have been awarded and presented to the perspective recipients all applications along with any documentation gathered by the voting members of the Scholarship Committee will be destroyed. None of the information personal or otherwise will be released or returned to the applicant or any other individual. There are no exceptions to this rule.
