



Exploring Career Paths: High School Students Get Hands on Experience

MSO put on a Career Day to showcase alternative career paths that may or may not require a college degree in the onsite wastewater industry. Students participated in unique activities to broaden horizons and showcase alternative career paths that don't require a college degree, our local high school recently organized a unique activity that exposed students to the world of pipe systems, sewage, and septic installation. Through a series of hands-on activities, students gained valuable insights and developed new skills while discovering the diverse and fulfilling opportunities in these fields.



1. Building a Pipe System:

Students were introduced to the fundamentals of pipe systems, learning how they function in various settings.

They had the chance to design and construct a basic pipe system, under the guidance of experienced professionals. Impact: This activity not only allowed students to get their hands dirty but also fostered teamwork and problem-solving skills. They gained a deeper appreciation for the complexity of pipe systems, and many discovered a newfound interest in this field.



2. Soil Evaluation Lab:

In this lab, students learned how to assess soil properties and suitability for various construction purposes. They assessed the soils by looking at texture, color, and structure.

Impact: Understanding soil properties is vital for successful pipe systems, sewage, and septic installation. This activity exposed students to the scientific aspects of these careers, highlighting the significance of soil analysis in ensuring infrastructure longevity and functionality.





3. Land Contours and Trench Technologies

Students were taught how to use a clinometer, an essential tool in professions related to pipe systems and construction. Students were given hands-on experience in measuring slopes with a clinometer and laser elevation tools. The different types of conventional treatment methods were discussed from the trench technologies available at the training center.

Impact: By mastering this precise instrument, students realized the importance of accuracy in construction work. They also grasped the connection between elevation and effective pipe system installation, opening their eyes to potential careers where this skill is crucial.

The Impact on These Kids:

Many students previously unaware of these non-college career paths now have a clearer picture of the opportunities available. The hands-on nature of these activities made learning engaging and memorable, and students appreciated the chance to apply theoretical knowledge in real-world scenarios.

Skill Development: Students developed valuable skills such as teamwork, problem-solving, and technical proficiency. Career Awareness: By interacting with industry professionals, students gained insights into the diverse job roles within pipe systems, sewage, and septic installation without having to obtain a college degree.

Important Updates from DHSS

The Onsite Wastewater Program has undergone some changes over the past 6 months and we want to make sure you are aware of a few items! Please note these important resources when you have questions on registration/licensure, CEUs or permitting.



















Installer Registration

If you are another person for your company is looking to become a registered installer, they will need to enroll in the in-person installer class and take the exam. These classes fill up approximately 2 months in advance so the earlier you can sign up the better. Paying online and returning your registration forms via email is the fastest way to enroll. Visit health.mo.gov/onsite and click on "Become Registered/Licensed" for available course dates, registration forms and link to pay online. Be sure to return your registration form via email once you have paid or you will not be registered. The Program will email you a confirmation once you are registered for a class.

When you are at the end of your 3-year period for your registration and are ready to renew, there are a few steps to do this:

- 1. Renewal notices are sent by mail to your last known address 60 days prior to expiration. If you do not have an accurate address at DHSS, you will not receive the form. If you are within 45 days of expiration and have not received your renewal form OR if your contact information has recently changed; contact the Program at OWTScourses@health.mo.gov.
- 2. Renewal fees can be paid online but the renewal form and CEU certificates must still be sent to the Program. The fastest method is to send via email to OWTScourses@health.mo.gov.
- 3. It takes up to 30 days for your renewal to be processed. That means if you submit your paperwork, on the last day of your certification, you may not get a recertification letter/card until a month later.
- 4. CEU Report: You are asked to submit your CEU certificates with your renewal. If you take MSO Seminar classes, these are automatically sent in. If you take MSO Online Classes or other classes outside of MSO, you must submit the completion certificates to DHSS. Either by email (OWTScourses@health.mo.gov) or by mail with your renewal form.
- 5. NOTE: ID Cards are sent out via email for electronic cards. They are no longer sent out in physical card format. Contact DHSS for questions on this: OWTScourses@health.mo.gov.

CEU Information

It is now the responsibility of the professional to track their own CEUs. DHSS is unable to provide reports or updates on the status of your CEUs throughout your certification period. DHSS did create an Excel spreadsheet for you to track your own CEUs. This does require Excel to run.

Permitting

A construction permit is required before installing or repairing most onsite wastewater treatment systems (OWTS). Some single-family residential lots may be exempt from permitting. The first step of the permitting process is to determine the agency that has permitting authority where the work is being done.



DHSS OWTS permitting falls under one of three authority types: DHSS Onsite Program, Local Authority (contract), or Local Authority via Ordinance. The application process varies by permitting authority. Work should not begin until a permit has been issued or an exemption to permitting has been confirmed by the appropriate permitting authority.







